		This Risk Assessment is implemented to reduce the spread of Covid-19 in our setting. The fundamental principle is to ensure good hygiene practices and physical distancing between children and staff.
CHILDREN	ENTRANCE & ATTENDANCE	<ul> <li>Only children who are symptom free or who have completed the required isolation period will attend the setting.</li> <li>Children's temperatures are taken on arrival these must read between 36-37.8 degrees for normal temperature. If the child has a temperature outside of this, they will be asked to return home for testing.</li> <li>A guideline of acceptable temperatures is on view, a thermometer is available at all 3 entrances.</li> <li>All children will use 3 separate entrances/exits to aid social distancing. Parents and visitors are not permitted inside the setting.</li> </ul>
CHILDREN	DISTANCING & GROUPS	<ul> <li>When inside, children wash or use antibacterial gel, they remove their shoes and outerwear.</li> <li>Children are organised into small groups and are not mixed throughout the day.</li> <li>Outdoor space is used at different times of the day for each group.</li> <li>The children are provided with varied space in the rooms to move around and spread out.</li> </ul>
CHILDREN	WELLBEING & EDUCATION	<ul> <li>A calm and safe environment will continue for the children.</li> <li>Key persons will ensure children receive emotional support.</li> <li>Sand &amp; Water play is on hold at present.</li> <li>Some soft toys &amp; furnishings have been removed; others are laundered after each use.</li> <li>Toys that can be 'mouthed' by young children have been assessed and reduced accordingly.</li> <li>They children are taught how to wash their hands correctly; pictures are displayed in each toilet.</li> </ul>
STAFF WHICH INCLUDES STUDENTS & VISITORS	ENTRANCE & ATTENDANCE	<ul> <li>The nappy changing areas are disinfected after each use and are used for one child at a time.</li> <li>Staff are expected to travel alone to work. If public transport is used or by other means, they must bring a change of clothes to prevent cross contamination.</li> <li>All temperatures are checked upon entrance, these must read between 36-37.8 degrees for normal temperature. If a staff member has a temperature outside of this, they will be asked to return home for testing. Alternatively carry out a Rapid Antigen Test at nursery.</li> <li>Staff may only return to nursery if they are symptom free, have completed the required isolation period or achieved a Negative Test Result.</li> <li>Face coverings are recommended to be worn throughout the day.</li> <li>All staff must wash or apply antibacterial gels upon entrance and change into uniform.</li> </ul>

STAFF WHICH INCLUDES STUDENTS & VISITORS	TRAINING	<ul> <li>All staff are aware of our Policies &amp; Risk Assessments for Covid-19</li> <li>Staff have accessed the Prevent Covid-19 Training.</li> <li>Staff carry out a Self-Audit and Monitoring Form, monthly or earlier if necessary.</li> <li>Staff complete their own room risk assessments.</li> </ul>
STAFF WHICH INCLUDES STUDENTS & VISITORS	DISTANCING & GROUPS	<ul> <li>Staff will remain in their own groups where possible.</li> <li>Social distancing will be maintained during break times, this is achieved by staggered lunch times and dividing space in the staffroom.</li> <li>Staff members will avoid physical contact with each other. If staff must pass each other, then back-to-back passing is essential.</li> <li>Staff must provide all their own cups, plates, and cutlery, these can be washed at the nursery immediately.</li> </ul>
PARENTS	SOCIAL DISTANCING	<ul> <li>Parents will drop off and collect at specific doors.</li> <li>Parents will socially distance from each other and not congregate together for any reason.</li> <li>Parents will ring each doorbell (cleaned regularly) and a member of staff will collect the child.</li> <li>Parents must not drop off or collect their child outside of their allotted session times.</li> <li>Parents must not bring children to the setting if they or anyone in their family is displaying any symptoms of Covid-19.</li> <li>Verbal handover information is restricted to ensure a queue does not form. Additional information is gained by telephoning or e-mailing the setting.</li> <li>Parents must always wear face coverings/masks.</li> <li>If parents do enter the setting, then strict rules apply including hand washing, wearing face masks, removing shoes and outerwear, temperature checks and social distancing rules apply</li> </ul>
ALL	GENERAL HYGIENE & HEALTH & SAFETY	<ul> <li>All children and staff must wash or use antibacterial gel on their hands upon arrival and throughout the day from the provided stations.</li> <li>An enhanced daily cleaning schedule is in place which includes:</li> <li>Furniture and surfaces</li> <li>Children's toys and equipment.</li> <li>Toilets &amp; nappy changing areas (which are also are sanitised throughout the day)</li> </ul>

ALL	HANDWASHING	<ul> <li>Door handles, light switches, handrails, doorbells, stairgates, telephones &amp; taps.</li> <li>Sand &amp; Water play is on hold at present.</li> <li>Some soft toys &amp; furnishings have been removed; others are laundered after each use.</li> <li>All electronic equipment such as Laptops, tablets, and computers are sanitised.</li> <li>Laundry such as bedding is only used by one child and laundered separately, daily.</li> <li>Face flannels are used by one child and laundered separately, daily.</li> <li>Upon arrival in the morning and throughout the day.</li> <li>After physical contact with others</li> <li>After handling any post or parcels (gloves should be worn)</li> <li>Before eating or drinking</li> <li>After using the toilet</li> <li>After coughing or sneezing</li> <li>Before and after the preparation of food</li> <li>If hands are visibly dirty</li> <li>When moving from one room to another</li> </ul>
STAFF WHICH INCLUDES STUDENTS & VISITORS	PPE	The following items of PPE are available to all staff:  • Face masks  • Hand sanitiser  • Bleach and cleaning fluids  • Gloves  • Aprons  PPE will continue to be worn for normal practice such as nappy changing and the administration of First Aid.
ALL	BUILDING	<ul> <li>Windows will be kept open where possible to ensure ventilation. There is no air conditioning.</li> <li>Children are not permitted to bring in items from home, unless essential to their well-being.</li> <li>An independent cleaner operates daily.</li> <li>If emergency repairs are needed, these will be carried out outside of business hours where possible.</li> </ul>
ALL	SUPPLIES	<ul> <li>We ensure an adequate supply of essential items to minimise the impact of any shortages.</li> <li>We keep a small back-up supply of such stock.</li> <li>In the case that the supply of food is interrupted, procedures will be implemented to ensure that appropriate food alternatives are offered, and normal food hygiene processes are followed.</li> <li>All shopping that arrives at the setting is surface cleaned and gloves must be worn.</li> </ul>

ALL	KITCHEN	<ul> <li>The kitchen is predominately used by the Chef, who is responsible for administering the correct procedures for cooking and delivering in line with EHO regulations.</li> <li>An upgraded cleaning process is in place which is carried out daily.</li> <li>If staff must enter the area, then social distancing rules apply.</li> </ul>
ALL	RESPONDING TO A SUSPECTED CASE OF COVID-19	<ul> <li>If a child develops any of the recognised coronavirus symptoms whilst attending the setting, they will be collected as soon as possible and isolated at home in line with current NHS guidance.</li> <li>Whilst waiting to be collected, they will be moved into a room where they can be isolated with a key person.</li> <li>A window will be opened for ventilation</li> <li>If the child should require the toilet whilst waiting, then this area will be disinfected after use.</li> <li>The staff member will wear appropriate PPE and remain distanced at 2m</li> <li>If the child becomes seriously unwell, then 999 will be called.</li> <li>In the event of a staff member displaying symptoms, they will be required to go home immediately and be tested as soon as possible for Covid-19</li> <li>If a member in their household displays any symptoms, then they will be sent home immediately until the family member receives a result.</li> <li>If the test returns as Positive, then the staff member must self-isolate for 14 days, and can return after this time providing they do not display any symptoms.</li> <li>If the test returns as Negative, then they may return immediately. Proof of the result will be required.</li> <li>If a member of staff contracts Covid-19 whilst in the setting then we will report this to Public Health South-West.</li> <li>If more than one staff member contracts Covid-19 at any one time, then we will report this to RIDDOR.</li> </ul>
